



FAITH METHODIST CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP FOR THEOLOGICAL STUDIES AT TRINITY THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE (TTC)

VALUE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The scholarship will cover:

1. All fees pertaining to academics and maintenance for one person (around S\$17,000 per annum per student, based on 2015 figures);
2. Approved airfare for one trip to Singapore to start the programme, and one trip back to the home country upon completion of the programme;
3. An initial arrival allowance, including visa reimbursement where applicable; and
4. At the discretion of Faith Methodist Church, other expenses may also be defrayed.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants must first be recommended by TTC, before being endorsed by Faith Methodist Church. The prescribed forms are to be used and may be obtained from TTC. Together with this, the following documents must also be submitted:

1. A supporting letter from the Home Institution (i.e. church or Christian organization);
2. A professional/pastoral reference;
3. An indicative budget; and
4. A personal testimony.

UNDERTAKING BY RECIPIENT

The scholarship is tenable only at TTC, and the recipient must undertake to fulfil the following:

1. To reside in Singapore during term time, unless explicit permission from TTC has been granted;
2. To devote his/her time and energy to his/her studies to ensure satisfactory progress and completion;
3. To attend the worship services of Faith Methodist Church for at least a year;
4. To return to his/her home country to serve, upon completion of the degree programme;

5. Not to seek employment in Singapore for at least three years after the completion of his/her studies; and
6. Not to hold concurrently any other scholarship, fellowship or bursary, without the approval of Faith Methodist Church.

DISQUALIFICATION AND CESSATION

Faith Methodist Church reserves the right to reduce, suspend or terminate the scholarship immediately, and without notice, if the recipient:

1. Commits a criminal offence;
2. Conducts himself/herself in manner that compromises academic integrity;
3. Is disciplined by TTC for breach of its regulations;
4. Is expelled by TTC;
5. Participates in activities or acts in a manner which is detrimental to the ethos and good witness of Christianity; or
6. Breaches any of the terms and conditions herein.
