I bring you warm greetings from Trinity Theological College and trust that you have received the August Trumpet as well as the Invitation to our 70th Anniversary events on Friday, 5 October 2018. Here are some updates on our celebrations.

1. Every year, TTC's anniversary is celebrated as a two-part event: a worship service in the morning and a thanksgiving dinner in the evening. The dinner guest list consists primarily of individual donors, donor churches, special partners and alumni. Hence, it is a 'thanksgiving' dinner to acknowledge all who have been supporting TTC.
2. For the 70th Anniversary, we are pleased that our former principals and some former faculty members from overseas have already indicated that they will join the celebrations. Overseas alumni have also begun to confirm their participation.
3. We are looking forward to welcome YOU to our 70th Anniversary Service as well as the Thanksgiving Dinner. Here are some details of our celebrations:
 - 70th Anniversary Service at 11am in the Chapel. The speaker will be Bishop Dr Chong Chin Chung, Bishop of The Methodist Church in Singapore and an alumnus of TTC.
 - 70th Anniversary Thanksgiving Dinner at 7.20pm at the Orchid Country Club. The Guest of Honour for the evening's dinner will be Mr Teo Chee Hean, Deputy Prime Minister and Coordinating Minister for National Security. The highlights of the dinner programme include
 - A speech by the Guest of Honour.
 - A bi-lingual Commemorative Magazine to be presented to all guests.
 - A Video Clip of TTC in English and Chinese.
 - Sharing of the next phase of our development and long-term projects for the prayerful consideration of our guests. However, there will be no fundraising at the dinner itself.

4. A heritage trail on the theme "After the Darkness...Lux Mundi" will be organised on 3 September exclusively for our local alumni. It will include a short lecture on the history of TTC, a testimony from an alumnus who is an ex-offender, and visits to Changi Prison Chapel and Mt Sophia. A specially designed umbrella and t-shirt will be sold during the heritage trail to raise \$70,000 for the theological education of ex-offenders. Alumni donations now stand at \$3,700. 5. As for overseas alumni who will be in TTC closer to the 70th Anniversary itself, we are organising the heritage trail specially for them to be held on 4 October.
